Bring your beautiful Hydrangea blooms from the garden into the home! In this workshops you will learn how and when to cut blooms for drying and how to best preserve them. You will also learn how to best cut and preserve the blooms for fresh use. The hands-on portion of the class will cover ideas for incorporating Hydrangeas into fresh floral arrangements. Buckets of cut Hydrangeas and a variety of other flowers will be available for use in the class. Each participant will go home with a finished arrangement. Propagating new plants from these shrubs by taking cuttings will also be discussed and practiced so you will go home with some new starts for your garden.

Please bring at least 1 vase with a maximum opening of 4" to arrange in, as well as a box for transporting your arrangements.

Please **bring your favorite clippers** and gloves.
