She will give demonstrations with the many varieties of lavender and show their versatile uses. At lunchtime we will taste goodies made with lavender.

A hands-on workshop is offered after lunch, where we will create fresh lavender items such as fragrant wands, mini baskets, or swags. Make an adorable petite everlasting lavender wreath.

You will go home with extra lavender for you to use at home. Lavender plants and products from the farm will be available for sale.
